Data privacy & protection

- consent for the collection of personal data (HR, location)
- limitations in the distribution of personal data

Intellectual property

- identification of data owner
- prohibition/limitation in data use and re-use

Cybersecurity

- protection of signal transmission
- protection of data storage
- data integrity and availability

Export control

- restrictions in data acquisition from foreign providers or in data dissemination to foreign users
- HR data, protected satellite systems

Challenges

- Private actors' involvement
- Different national laws, lacking/insufficient regulations
- Fast cross-border data transition
